PRIDE PARK at Folkets Park

1. Introduction

Pride Park (at Folkets Park) is where the Pride Parade finishes and where we continue our celebrations throughout the afternoon and evening. Pride Park is open during Saturday 6 July, one day only. Here you will be able to enjoy free concerts, buy food from our food truck vendors and local restaurants, and enjoy socializing with fellow LGBTQIA+ people. We think everyone belongs at Pride and want to extend a warm welcome to all of our Deaf and disabled visitors.

4. Venue Description

The main paths in Pride Park (Folkets Park) run as a loop throughout the entire park, and have a brick surface for increased accessibility. These paths should always be free of objects and obstacles. Other paths and areas in the park have varying surfaces, such as gravel, and accessibility for e.g. wheelchairs and walkers may vary depending on the weather.

During concerts and other events, there are designated spaces for those who use a wheelchair or for other reasons may need to stand separately or elevated.

5. Travel Guide

Folkets Park has several entrances. The main entrance is located on Norra Parkgatan, right at the junction with Amiralsgatan. Along Norra Parkgatan in the direction of Kristanstadsgatan, there are two more entrances, one at Friisgatan and the other at Barkgatan. There is another entrance on the opposite side of the park, located at the intersection of Falstebogatan and Trelleborgsgatan.

The closest bus stop is Malmö Folkets Park, which is located right outside of the main entrance.

The closest accessible parking can be found outside the main entrance in Norra Parkgatan. Norra Parkgatan 1 is the address recommended to give transport services (färdtjänst)



6. Arrival Guide

If you enter the park from the entrance in Norra Parkgatan, you will find Boulebar to your right and toilets to the left (including accessible toilets). If you move roughly 100 metres into the park you will find the Big Stage (Stora Scenen), and if you move roughly 50 more metres ahead you will find the Small Stage (Lilla Scenen). Across from the Small Stage you will find Moriska Paviljongen.

7. Toilets

Accessible toilets can be found on four locations in the park:

- The entrance by Amiralsgatan
- By the playgrounds
- Outside of Far i Hatten
- By the Park's Office (Parkkontoret)

8. Visitors with Medical Requirements

We welcome visitors who need to bring medicines, medical equipment, food or drink to manage a medical condition. If you have any concerns or questions then please contact us at tillganglighet@malmopride.com.

In case of emergency, approach anyone wearing a Malmö Pride t-shirt or Volunteer badge, or call the police by dialling 112.

9. Access to events

All events in Pride Park are accessible, including the concerts, Schlagerbaren in Boulebaren, and the Closing party (Malmö Prides Official Slutfest) in Moriska Paviljongen.

Unfortunately we are not able to provide Swedish Sign Language interpretation, captioning, or visual description at all our events. 10. Talking and noise

Assistance dogs are welcome in the park if they are wearing dog leashes.

The concerts in the park may feature strobe lighting or loud noise. We recommend that people sensitive to noise bring noise cancelling headphones or earbuds.
